

**NORTHERN RIO GRANDE CONFERENCE  
COMPETITION GUIDELINES**  
(Revised May 17, 2017 at a Special Spring Meeting)

**I. NRG COMPETITION SPORTS**

**A. BASKETBALL**

Boys/Girls basketball tournament will be held on the first weekend in January unless dates conflict with holidays. Host site for both tournaments will be determined at previous Winter Meeting.

**a. Seeding**

1. Girls and boys tournament seeding will be done at the winter meeting, respectively, based on season record recorded to date.
2. Tournament
  - i. If teams play each other twice, count both games.
  - ii. Seeding includes all games played against Varsity teams regardless of class competition.
  - iii. In ties, percentage-wise, the winner in head to head competition takes the higher seed.
  - iv. Tied teams which have not played each other, flip of coin.
  - v. Three-way or more ties; odd man takes higher seed. Remaining coaches flip. (Must flip cannot decide on basis of who beat whom in previous wins).

**b. Bracket**

1. Higher seeds have choice of bench and will wear light uniforms.

**c. Tickets**

1. A maximum of 20 complimentary entrees will be permitted for each team. Plus three (3) administrative complimentary passes per school (Superintendent-Principal-Athletic Director/Athletic Coordinator).
2. Each officer will receive three complimentary entrees.
3. First game roster regarding numbers not to exceed 14 players per team (maximum). These players must be included as players throughout the tournament, unless replaced through a medical release. Cheerleaders and their sponsor(s) must have complimentary list.
4. Athletic/Activities Directors must provide letters of bus drivers and chaperones for free admission.
5. Everyone must have a ticket.
6. In setting ticket prices, consider even numbers in change making.
7. All tickets must be sold at game place.

d. Awards

1. Team Trophies---first, second, third, and consolation champ. The fourth place team will be recognized over the public address system
- e. Game ball to be provided by the Tournament Director for use during the tournament. (not to be presented as an award)

f. Officials

1. Selection of tournament officials to take place at the previous Fall Meeting by member school coaches or athletic directors.
2. Two (2) officials per game with the exception of semi-finals and championship game where three (3) officials will be selected.

B. TRACK

NRG Track meet will be held during week prior to District meets. Host site opportunity to be rotated as follows: Dulce 2020, Questa 2021, McCurdy 2022, Mesa Vista 2023, Escalante 2024, Penasco 2025, Mora 2018 and Pecos 2019. If designated host declines, then that opportunity is forfeited and next member schools may accept or decline in order of rotation until a host site is determined.

1. Setting of Heats

- a. Coaches will have names and times ready to give to the Meet Director before the meeting.
- b. Times must be times run in an official meet.
- c. Order of events: Follow State Standard Order of Events.  
Exception: Girls 3200 meter run will be the first running event of the day.
- d. Lane assignments.
  - i. Seeding Curved races: 2-3-4-5-6-7-8-1
  - ii. Seeding Straight races (8 lanes) 4-5-6-3-2-7-8-1
  - iii .Seeding Straight races (6 lanes) 3-4-2-5-1-6

2. Awards

- a. Team Trophies – 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>. If full contingent, add 3<sup>rd</sup> place trophy
- b. Individual Awards – medals to 1<sup>st</sup> place, ribbons to 2<sup>nd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> places.

## **II. Salaries**

1. President .....\$300.00
2. Vice President.....\$200.00
3. Secretary/Treasurer.....\$250.00
4. Bookkeeping.....\$200.00
5. Track Meet Director.....\$150.00
6. Track Meet Referee.....\$75.00
7. Track Clerk of Course (Back up Starter).....\$75.00
8. Track Meet Starter.....\$100.00
9. Basketball Tournament Directors Salary will be determined by number of duties assigned. (open)
10. Tournament Officials (conference officers) shall be paid \$200.00 to run the tournament, plus mileage from their respective schools at the prevailing State rates. Conference officers will administer the NRGC basketball tournament. For example: collect tickets and help with supervision at every session. This will be for both boys and girls.

These NRG Conference Competition Guidelines shall be amended only upon the majority vote of a quorum of member schools present at a Special Meeting. Amended Guidelines become effective at the beginning of the year after amended.
